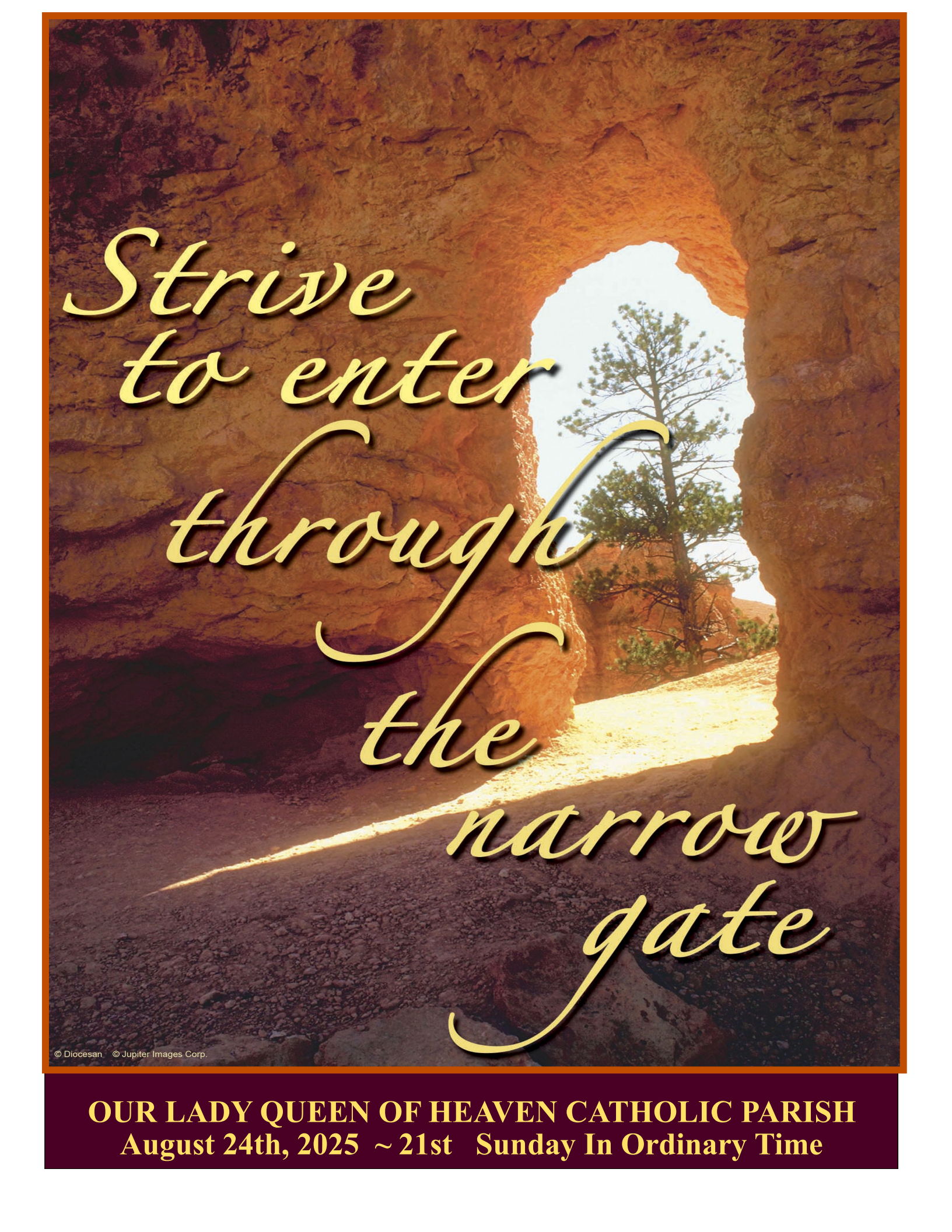

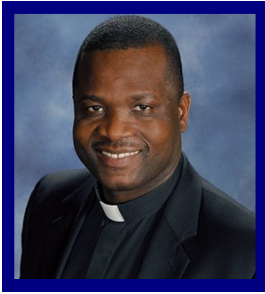

Shortcuts take longer

Some friends are famous for their shortcuts—the kind that always take them longer than if they had stuck to the main routes. There are also those who never follow the instruction manual that comes with the items to be assembled, and it almost always end up doing it wrong. Cutting corners rarely winds up with satisfying results. Bakers know that if you use inferior ingredients, you can expect inferior outcomes. Thrown-together carpentry work tumbles apart in short order. Failing to warm up before exercise puts us at risk of injury. Doing things right takes more time and care, but it gets the job done. In moral living and relationship with Christ, the narrow gate is the most direct route to where we’re going. Avoid easy. Choose marvelous.

YOUTH GROUP

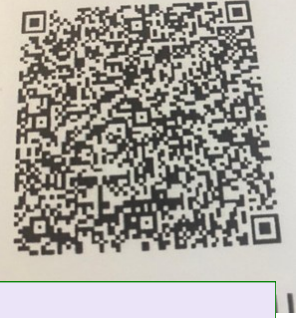
