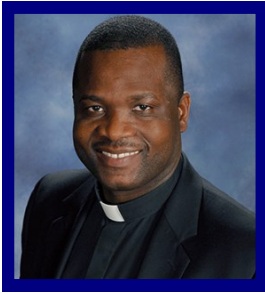

¿Qué significa renunciar a las posesiones al seguimiento de Jesús? La tradición monástica reconoce que incluso poseer una cuchara es espiritualmente peligroso si la cuchara a su vez nos posee. La mayoría de nosotros poseemos mucho más que utensilios. Podemos considerar el ejemplo del humanista Santa Madre Teresa. No era una mujer o religiosa perfecta ni una teóloga impecable. Madre Teresa se equivocó en muchas cosas en su misión de caridad en India. Pero acertó en algo: el respeto a la vida es lo más importante, y los recursos de la sociedad deben servir a la vida como su principal fundamento ético. Ofrece tus tesoros materiales al servicio de la vida en el nombre de Jesús.

What does it mean to renounce possessions in following Christ? Monastic tradition recognizes that even owning a spoon is spiritually dangerous if the spoon possesses us back. Most of us own far more than utensils. We might consider the example of catholic humanitarian Blessed Mother Theresa. She wasn't a perfect woman or religious nor a flawless theologian. Blessed Mother Teresa got a lot wrong about her mission of charity in India. But, girl, did she got one thing very very right: Reverence for life is paramount, and society's resources should serve life as its primary ethical foundation. Place your worldly treasure at the service of life in the name of Christ.

Una Nueva Evangelización

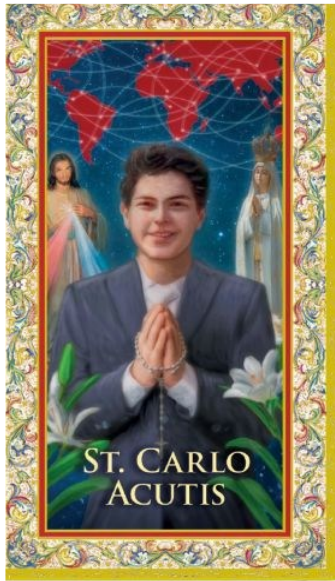
Duración: 15 sesiones

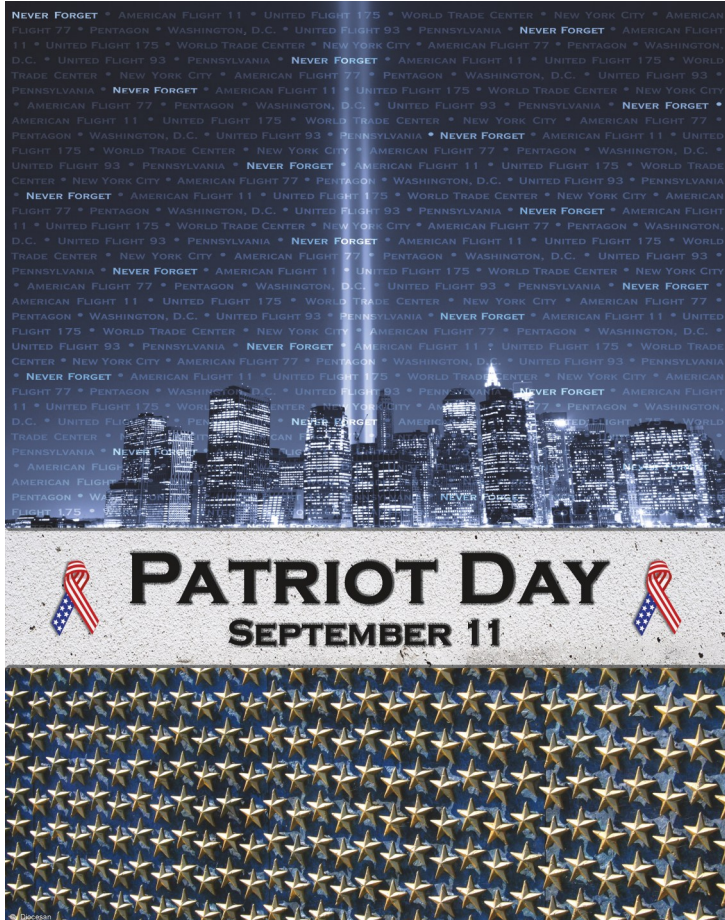


Prayer for Saint Carlo Acutis

On September 7, 2025, Blessed Carlo Acutis will be canonized, officially becoming the first millennial saint of the Catholic Church. The historic ceremony, led by Pope Leo XIV in [St. Peter's Square](#), will also elevate Blessed [Pier Giorgio Frassati](#) to sainthood. Acutis, who died in 2006, is known for his deep devotion to the Eucharist and his use of technology to share his faith, creating an online exhibit of Eucharistic miracles.
