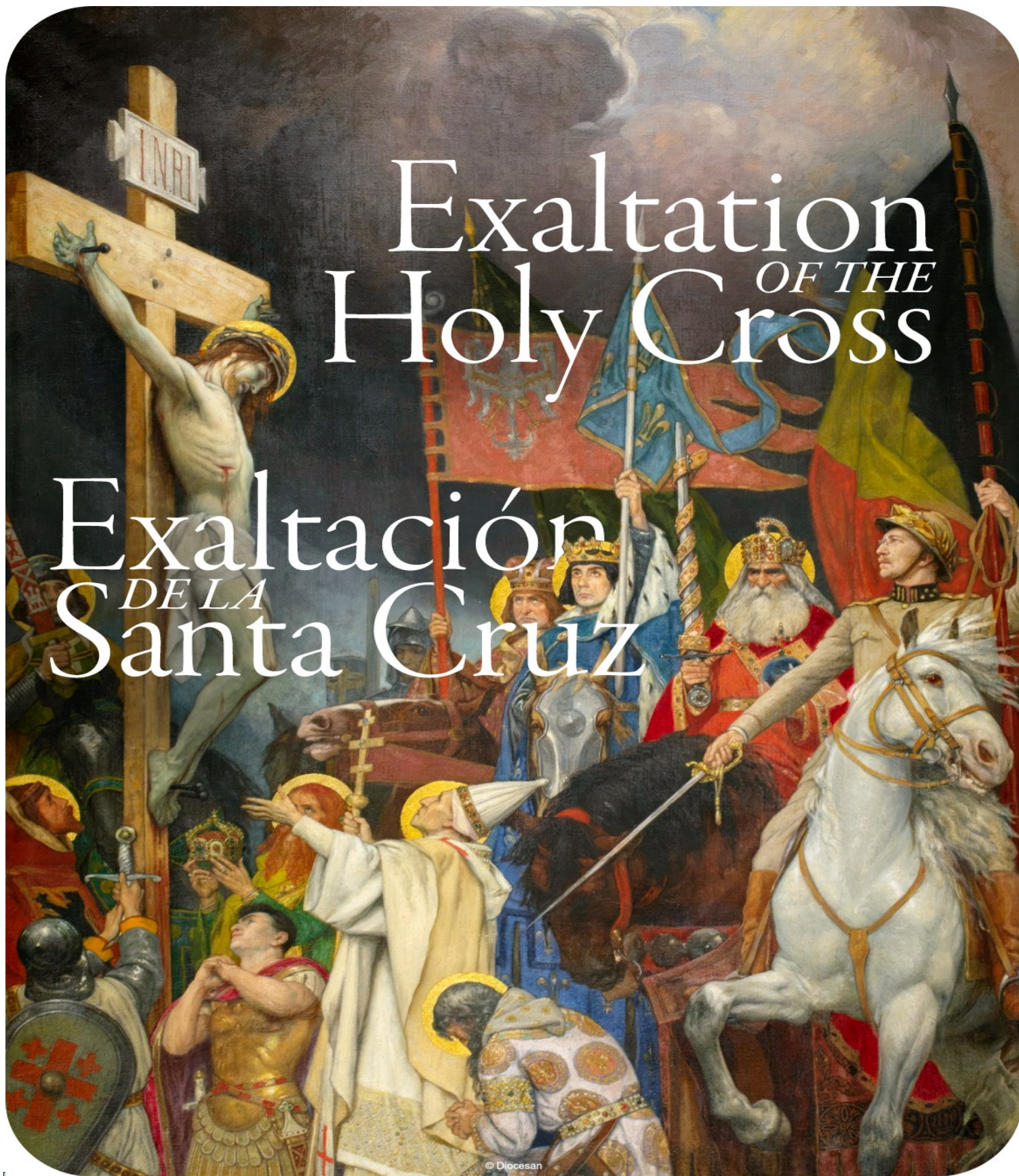

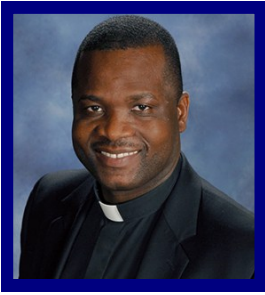

Comprender la cultura cruzada

No siempre es fácil afrontar las cosas que nos duelen a nosotros o a nuestros seres queridos. Entonces, ¿por qué levantaríamos la cruz, honrando aquello que simboliza el dolor y la muerte de Jesús? Como cristianos, elegimos enfrentar la cruz. Al hacerlo, confrontamos no solo la realidad del sufrimiento y la muerte, sino también la esperanza y la creencia en una nueva vida, en ese "algo más" de la salvación. Y de alguna manera, al enfrentar nuestro dolor, en lugar de fingir que no existe o encubrir la realidad, reconocemos nuestra vulnerabilidad. Nos abrimos a la sanación. La exaltación de la cruz no es sólo un recordatorio de la muerte de Jesús sino de su Resurrección. Es una invitación a elevar nuestro propio dolor y encontrar en él un camino hacia la sanación y la plenitud. Uno de los mejores consejos que recibí fue: si quieres fortalecer tu fe con el paso del tiempo, dedica cinco minutos al día a orar de rodillas ante la cruz.

Understanding cross culture

It's not always easy to face the things that hurt us or our loved ones. So why would we lift up the cross in exaltation, honouring that which symbolizes pain and the death of Jesus? As Christians we choose to face the cross. In doing so we confront not only the reality of suffering and death but also the hope and belief in new life, in that "something more" of salvation. And somehow in facing our pain, instead of pretending it isn't there or whitewashing the reality, there is acknowledgement of our vulnerability. We become open to healing. The exaltation of the cross is not only a reminder of Jesus' death but of his Resurrection. It is an invitation to lift up our own pain and find in it a path to healing and wholeness. One of the best advices I received: Spend five minutes daily on your knees before the cross if you wish to strengthen your faith over time.
